The Annual Family Camp will again be held at Roonka, from the 21-23 February 2014!

Roonka is a Scout owned Campsite on the banks of the Murray just north of Blanchetown, only about 2½ hours from Adelaide.

Campers can arrive from 2pm on the Friday, and must depart by 2pm on Sunday. You are welcome to invite family friends along.

Accommodation options (first booked, first in basis) are:

Camp Sites - Unpowered or Powered for your tents, swags, Camper Trailers or Caravans.

Bunkhouse –are also available. They accommodate 6, 10 or 12 people, so you may need to share with another family.

More details on the camp (including costs) will be sent home later this term, with bookings and payment required Week 1 of Term 1, 2014.

Please note this is not a formal Scout Group Camp, but a Family Camp where parents, not Leaders, are responsible for their own children.
